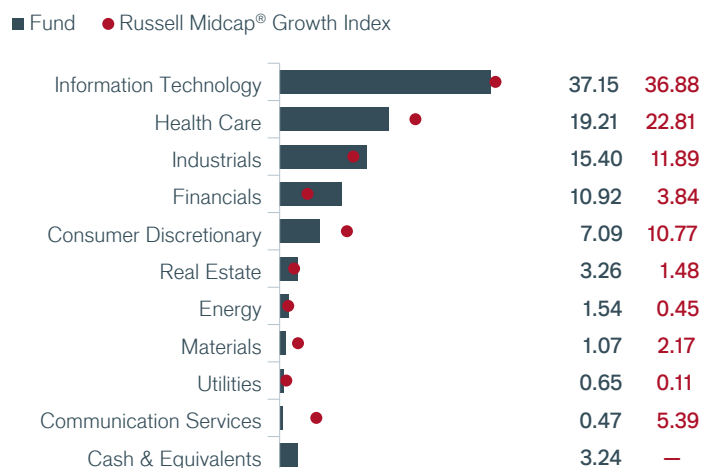

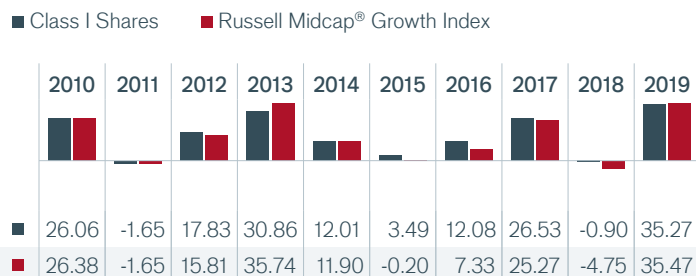

Russell Midcap® Growth Index reflects the performance of U.S. mid-cap equities with higher price-to-book ratios and higher forecasted growth values. **Alpha** compares risk-adjusted performance relative to an index. Positive alpha means outperformance on a risk-adjusted basis. **Beta** measures the volatility of a security or portfolio relative to an index. Less than one means lower volatility than the index; more than one means greater volatility. **R-squared (R²)** measures the relationship between portfolio and index performance on a scale of 0.00 (0%) to 1.00 (100%). A higher R² indicates more of the portfolio's performance is affected by market movements and vice versa. **Standard Deviation** measures historical volatility. Higher standard deviation implies greater volatility. **Sharpe Ratio** measures risk-adjusted performance using excess returns versus the "risk-free" rate and the volatility of those returns. A higher ratio means better return per unit of risk. **Active Share** represents the portion of portfolio holdings that differ from an index. **Turnover** is a measure of portfolio trading activity. Higher turnover may indicate higher transaction costs and vice versa.
