

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR DANISH INVESTORS**

**Relating to the issue of share of Janus Henderson Capital Funds plc**

**This supplement dated 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2019 (the “Supplement”) forms part of, and must be read in conjunction with, the prospectus of the Company issued on 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2019, as amended from time to time (the “Prospectus”).**

All capitalised terms used herein shall have the same meaning in this Supplement as in the Prospectus, unless otherwise indicated.

### **PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION OF THE COMPANY IN DENMARK**

All sub-funds (“Funds”) of the Company which are available for subscription have been notified with the Danish Financial Supervisory Authority for public distribution to eligible investors in Denmark.

All shares of the Funds (“Shares”) shall be issued as provided in the Prospectus.

Skandinaviska Enskil Banken, Denmark branch of Skandinaviska Enskilda Banken AB (Publ.), Sweden has been appointed as local paying agent and Danish representative in respect of all Shares (the “Paying Agent”).
